With its presence in the metropolitan Los Angeles area, All Saints Church has a long history of interfaith and ecumenical relationships and an ongoing commitment to local, national and global issues. The church strives to follow God's prophetic call to live out God's inclusive love through spirituality, community, and peace and justice.

The Director of Peace & Justice will embrace a vision of integrating spirituality with justice and peacemaking. The Director will coordinate the varied Peace & Justice ministries and activities of the parish and actively and effectively engage, inspire and expand the involvement of parishioners in the work of peace and justice. The Director liaises with organizations in the wider community and maintains strong interfaith connections. The successful candidate will be someone whose knowledge, enthusiasm and effectiveness will be so infectious that everyone who worships at All Saints will want to be more deeply engaged in works of service, compassion, social justice and peacemaking.

The position requires:

- Demonstrated ability to cultivate lay leadership and inspire parishioners and the larger community for deeper involvement in the work of faith-based peace and justice;
- A combination of relevant education and strong experience in a similar or related position or setting;
- Ability to form and articulate theological rationales for public policy positions;
- Ability to work cross-culturally;
- Ability to work with a spirited, well-informed and intellectually and theologically stimulating parish;
- Excellent skills in organizing people and programs, communication, administration and managing a budget;
- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team, to effectively supervise others (including effectively delegating responsibility as appropriate) and to identify and develop resources within the parish;
- Knowledge of local, national and international issues as well as the curiosity and ability to research issues and develop educational resources for the parish;
- Ability to oversee a process of tracking legislation through legislative bodies.

Bilingual (Spanish/English) communication skills are highly desirable. The Director of Peace & Justice must be present for Sunday services and for other weekend duties.

Being committed to an ongoing process of multiculturalism and inclusion, we encourage applications from women, persons of color, differently-abled and gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender persons. We are an equal opportunity employer.
